### Project Complete: Greater Nanaimo Pollution Control Centre Outfall Replacement

The Regional District of Nanaimo is happy to announce that the Greater Nanaimo Pollution Control Centre (GNPCC) Outfall Replacement Project is now complete! The new outfall is expected to manage treated effluent from GNPCC for 70 years or more. Remediation of Morningside Park will follow.

### GNPCC Secondary Treatment Upgrade Project - Construction to Start Spring 2017

The GNPCC Secondary Treatment Upgrade Project has arrived at its next milestone. Engineering design is complete and the RDN is tendering the construction contract. Construction is expected to start in the spring of 2017 and take approximately two years to complete.

GNPCC currently provides chemically-enhanced primary treatment for wastewater from the City of Nanaimo, Snuneymuxw First Nation and parts of the District of Lantzville. Secondary Treatment will meet and exceed all provincial and federal requirements. The upgrade will improve the quality of effluent discharged to the Strait of Georgia.
