

DUKE POINT

- Built 1981; Upgraded in 1999
- > RDN Assumed Ownership in 1999
- Secondary Treatment with UV Disinfection; Marine Outfall








DUKE POINT

- Capacity = 910 m³/day
- Serves 22 Industrial Clients & Secondary School
- Will Eventually Service Cedar Village Centre & Cedar Estates








AREA A SERVICING

- Capacity of DPPCC Expanded to Village Centre/Cedar Estates
- Gravity System to be Installed by End of 2009
- Trunk Line Sized to Serve Cedar UCB








AREA A SERVICING

- Limited Access to Grants









Septic Smart






LWMP
