



**Clay Banks**  
 Pause at this point to see an environmental point of interest across the river.

**The Long Run**  
 Enjoy a peaceful picnic at the historic Steelhead spawning area. This rest spot provides seating and kiosks with more information about the park and river.

**The Hatchery and Side Channel**  
 The Department of Fisheries and Oceans Canada operates a side channel within the park to support fish habitat, specifically Coho salmon. Complete your visit to the park with a visit to the Hatchery and to the Chinook rearing pond.

**Conservation Zones within the Park**  
 The Englishman River Regional Park was first acquired in large part due to its environmentally significant characteristics. Most areas throughout the park are sensitive habitats, even though trails are still visible and accessible. The RDN asks you to please stay on the marked trails and to avoid walking in these environmentally sensitive areas.  
 We share this park with cougar, bear, elk, and beaver. Be aware and be safe!
