

SUBJECT: Appointment of Deputy General Manager of Development Services

PURPOSE

To consider appointing the Manager of Engineering Standards and Subdivision and the Manager of Community Planning as Deputy General Managers of Development Services to allow for the duties authorized under:

- "Regional District of Nanaimo Impact Assessment Bylaw No. 1165, 1999," and
- "Regional District of Nanaimo Delegation of Authority Bylaw No. 1166, 1999."

BACKGROUND AND IMPLICATIONS

"Regional District of Nanaimo Impact Assessment Bylaw No. 1165, 1999," provides the General Manager of Development Services the authority to require development approval information to be provided at the applicant's expense as part of the rezoning and development permit approval process. It also authorizes the General Manager to require the applicants to submit the proposal to a public information meeting.

"Regional District of Nanaimo Delegation of Authority Bylaw No. 1166, 1999," delegates to the General Manager of Development Services the power to issue a development permit under Section 919.1 of the Local Government Act. under certain circumstances.

With the vacant General Manager position and no Deputy having been appointed, these duties can not be performed. Those duties are necessary to efficiently and effectively undertake the responsibilities of both the Manager of Engineering Standards and Subdivision and the Manager of Community Planning. Therefore, it is requested that the persons in these positions each be appointed as Deputy General Managers of Development Services for the purposes of "Regional District of Nanaimo Impact Assessment Bylaw No. 1165, 1999," and "Regional District of Nanaimo Delegation of Authority Bylaw No. 1166, 1999," until the vacant General Manager of Development Services position is filled.

ALTERNATIVES

- 1. To appoint the Deputy General Managers of Development Services as requested.
- 2. To appoint another person as Deputy General Manager of Development Services.
- 3. To not appoint a person to the position and have the noted duties not performed.

VOTING

Electoral Area Directors - one vote, except Electoral Area 'B'.

SUMMARY

The General Manager of Development Services performs the duties required under:

- · "Regional District of Nanaimo Impact Assessment Bylaw No. 1165, 1999," and
- "Regional District of Nanaimo Delegation of Authority Bylaw No. 1166, 1999."

These duties are necessary to undertake the responsibilities of both the Manager of Engineering Standards and Subdivision and the Manager of Community Planning. Therefore, it is requested that the persons in these positions be appointed as Deputy General Managers of Development Services for the purposes of these bylaws until the vacant General Manager position is filled.

RECOMMENDATION:

 That the Manager of Engineering Standards and Subdivision and the Manager of Community Planning each be appointed as Deputy General Managers of Development Services for the purposes of "Regional District of Nanaimo Impact Assessment Bylaw No. 1165, 1999," and "Regional District of Nanaimo Delegation of Authority Bylaw No. 1166, 1999," until the vacant General Manager of Development Services position is filled.
