This bylaw extends the boundaries of the French Creek Village Streetlighting Local Service Area to include four properties in Electoral Area 'G'.

Bylaw No. 1646 (All Directors – One Vote)

This Bylaw establishes a service to provide improvements to the water system for fire protection for all of the Shorewood/San Pareil subdivision.

Mid Vancouver Island Habitat Enhancement Society (MVIHES) is requesting a letter of support for a project application. We believe our project, Groundwater Mapping and Education in the Englishman River Watershed Phase 2, addresses many of the goals in the RDN Action for Water plan established by the Board in 2008. As the Drinking Water and Watershed Protection Plan states, it wants "to support non-government organizations that assist in collecting field data and delivering education programs", which is what we are planning to do.

The MVIHES project, will characterize the bedrock aquifers in the ER and thus will advance the goal in the Action for Water plan to improve the "understanding of our watersheds and water resources". As we will provide a template of how the project is conducted, it will also assist in the goal of "Improved data collection, analysis and mapping of the Region's aquifers (groundwater sources) rivers and streams - this information will be used to develop a better understanding of those surface and groundwater sources and to protect the "recharge areas" for our water supplies."

Our project has an education component that will inform and train residents, including youth, and volunteers through lectures, workshops, articles, social media, field trips and monitoring activities, all contributing to a better knowledge of what makes for a healthy watershed.


MVIHES also plans to start a program of public awareness focusing on the need for groundwater regulation/protection because, right now "no one agency has the clear responsibility to look at a watershed as a whole and manage land use according to the values of that watershed." We want to make a case for the Englishman River watershed as a priority area in Water Act Modernization process.

The proposed Phase 2 is planned for year 2012 and 2013 and will be funded by several funding sources. MVIHES appreciates the support of the RDN in working towards a better understanding and protection of the Englishman River watershed.
