GRANTS IN AID

- Deadline for applications to the fall intake of the Electoral Area 'A' Grants in Aid program is Friday, September 29th, 2017.

SNUNEYMUXW SPORT COURT PROJECT

- Finishing work on the project continues with a significant portion of the sport court now complete. The full amount of the RDN Community Works Funds contribution of \$300,000 has been provided to Snuneymuxw First Nation.
- Although the increase of transit service hours in Electoral Area 'A' will not increase public transit options to the sport court, existing service via Route 7: Cinnabar/Cedar does provide service from the communities of Chase River and Cinnabar to a stop (northbound MacMillan at Duke Point) within walking distance.

CEDAR HERITAGE CENTRE

- The second and final installment of the \$6,000 total annual building management fee to Cedar School and Enhancement Society has been processed. The fee is provided to the Society for the booking and maintenance services provided at the Cedar Heritage Centre facility.
